

Dear Parents,

Summer School Registration is arriving soon! Beginning March 18<sup>th</sup>, parents will be able to register students for Summer School classes through our online information center, Skyward. With online registration, you have flexibility and control in being able to experiment with offerings and times, create a schedule, and know instantly the courses your child will be taking. No more waiting for the school to send the schedules – you can print your own from home. **Summer school classes offered are listed on the back of this page.**

Summer School courses are available on the School District of Westfield website for your viewing. Simply choose the classes that reflect your child's grade level for this current school year.

Summer school runs from Monday, June 10<sup>th</sup> – Friday, June 28<sup>th</sup>. Breakfast and lunch will be served and is FREE to all students. Busing is also available. Neshkoro pick-up is at 7:10, drop off is approx. 1:00. Coloma and Oxford pick-up is at 7:25, drop off is approx. 12:45. Old high school in Westfield pick-up is at 7:35, drop off is 12:35.

- Students may register for up to four sections. Look carefully at course descriptions as some run longer than one period.
- Swimming Lessons will run for the last two weeks of summer school from June 17<sup>th</sup> – June 28<sup>th</sup>. Students will be bussed from the Westfield Area High School at 8:00 to the Portage pool for swim lessons. They will be bussed back to the Westfield Area High School in time for lunch. Swimming Registration has to be filled out on line at <https://portage.recdesk.com>.
- If your High School or Middle School child is required to attend Remedial Summer School classes due to failing grades, he or she will not register for classes through Skyward. Students that attend Remedial Summer School classes receive a letter from Mr. Moody and fill out a paper registration form. The dates for Remedial Summer School are also different than Summer Adventure. Remedial Summer School runs from June 10<sup>th</sup> – June 28<sup>th</sup>, from 8:00 – 12:00.

**Online registration will go live on Monday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, at 12:00 am, and will close on Wednesday, May 01<sup>st</sup>, at 12:00 am. You can prepare for registration by making sure you are able to log in to Skyward before March 18<sup>th</sup>.**

#### **Skyward Family Access Login Guide**

- Go to the School District website: <http://www.westfield.k12.wi.us>
- Click on "Skyward Family & Student Access" - right hand side
- Enter your Login ID and Password.
- Click on Arena Scheduling, click on 2018-2019, and select individual student.
- If you are interested in swimming lessons you will need to register on line with the Portage pool. The website is <https://portage.recdesk.com>. On this website, click a link on the left labeled "Programs". Once there, search for individual swim lesson levels which will all be labeled "Westfield Schools Swim Lesson Level...". Each level will be individually labeled and the time corresponding as well. Once there, you can register for an account by scrolling down the bottom left side of the screen. Once an account is created, the pool must approve the account before you can sign up. The approval process is instant during the week, if students sign up in the evening or on a weekend it will be approved the next morning or on a Monday. **The fee for swimming is \$37 per participant. The check should be made out to the Westfield School District. Your student will give the fee to their secretary at their elementary school.**
