

Westfield Pioneers Softball Field Update

They dug out the pitching mound, catcher's box, and batter's boxes to insert clay bricks which will help protect those areas from getting dug out from wear. A machine was brought in to remove the lip of the infield. They also applied a heavy layer of "Turface Pro League," a material that has moisture-absorbing properties to improve footing and help prevent rain outs. Future projects include building a press box and installing fence cap around the field.
