Dear Parent/Guardian(s),

Vaccinations are one of the most important methods of protecting our children from diseases and the complications that can occur from these diseases. Vaccinations are especially important for school-aged children because children in school are regularly in close contact with others who may or may not be protected from these diseases.

Every year schools are required to assess all students' immunization records to determine compliance with the Wisconsin Student Immunization Law. Students have until the 30th school day to provide the appropriate documentation of immunization or a signed waiver. Starting on the 31st school day, noncompliant students may be excluded from school, in order to remain compliant with the law.

We would like to encourage you to contact your child's health care provider to check on your child's immunization status and schedule an appointment if needed to receive any vaccinations to ensure that your child is up-to-date for his/her age and is compliant with the Wisconsin Student Immunization Law. If your child does not have a health care provider, please contact your local health department to determine if your child is eligible to receive vaccinations at the health department.
